JUDGING CRITERIA AND PRIZE MONEY

Broodmares will be judged on conformation and potential as producers of racehorses. Blemishes and old injuries are not considered in the judging. All others will be judged as potential race horses based on conformation, athleticism, soundness and way of movement. Prize money in all non-championship classes will be divided as follows: 1st Place: \$125.00 and trophy, 2nd Place: \$75 and trophy, 3rd Place: \$30, 4th Place \$20.

CLASSES

- 1. \$250 Thoroughbred Broodmares:** Open to broodmares (barren or in foal) that meet current ownership or residency requirements for the West Virginia Thoroughbred Development Fund.
- 2. \$250 West Virginia Bred or Sired Foals of 2017-Fillies:** *May be at mare's side or weaned.*
- 3. \$250 West Virginia Bred or Sired Foals of 2017-Colts:** *May be at mare's side or weaned.*

West Virginia Bred Foals of 2017 Championship

Open to the first and second place winners in classes 2 & 3. Prize money: \$250 and Blanket to the champion and \$150 to the res. champion. NO ENTRY FEE

4. \$250 West Virginia Bred or Sired Yearling Fillies

5. \$250 West Virginia Bred or Sired Yearling Colts

West Virginia Bred Yearling Championship

Open to the first and second place winners in classes 4 & 5. Prize money: \$250 and Blanket to the champion and \$150 to the res. champion. NO ENTRY FEE

The Eleanor Casey Memorial Trophy

West Virginia Bred or Sired Young Horse Grand Championship

Open to the first and second place winners in classes 2, 3, 4 & 5. Prize money: \$300, Blanket and trophy to the champion and \$200 and trophy to the res. champion. NO ENTRY FEE

Rules

1. Negative Coggins test is required for all entries and must be presented for entry, including weaned foals. Foals of 2017 which have not been weaned do not require a separate Coggins.
2. Sportsmanlike behavior is encouraged and expected of all entrants. Those who do not comply may be excluded from participation.
3. Each class requires 3 entries to fill. Show management reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes that do not fill.
4. Horses which are unruly or out of control and present a danger to other exhibitors in the ring will be excused at the discretion of the judge.

Attire and Presentation

We have received numerous inquiries from participants in the last few years regarding appropriate attire and presentation of entries. Casual clothing is customarily worn for showing in hand, including khakis, polo shirts or similar clothing. Braiding of horses is optional, but normally entries are shown as one would see them presented at the sales—properly groomed with pulled manes, leather halters (with or without Chifney bits) and chain shanks or hunter-type bridles.
